





5.4.1. Update on previous planning applications:

17/00361/LBC & 17/00360/FUL. Mercure Parkside Hotel Newport Road, Listed building consent and planning permission for the proposed single storey dining Room and ancillary accommodation extension and associated external landscaping. *Permitted*.

17/01723/FUL 6 Braunston Woughton Park, Single storey rear and front extensions, first floor side, front and rear extensions and two storey rear extension. *Revised* submission permitted

17/01749/FUL 4 Newport Road Woughton On The Green, Erection of single family dwelling within the curtilage of no.4 Newport Road. *Pending*

17/01646/PNHSE 1 Adams Court Woughton On The Green Prior notification for a proposed single storey rear extension measuring 4 metres from the rear wall of the existing dwelling with a maximum ridge height of 4.0 metres and maximum eaves height of 2.5 metres. *Prior approval not required*

5.4.2. Planning applications since last meeting

17/02653/TPO 10 The Green Woughton On The Green, One Willow tree to be re-pollarded approximately 4 meters height. One semi mature Raywood ash to fell to ground level

17/02654/TPO 3 Pinkard Court Woughton On The Green, With a mixture of copping and pruning to clear a 2 meter wide strip adjustment to the two garden fence boundaries, also pruning where stems overhang into the cleared strip from the remaining hedgerow stems.

17/02786/TPO 8 Newport Road Woughton On The Green, Woughton Orchard-Ten willow trees to be re-pollarded down to historic pollard heads approximately 1.5 to 2.5 meters height. Length of stems to be removed are up to 10 meters. the work to be carried out during October 2018.
