Situation Update

We have received the following information in the past week that we wished to pass on.

- A number of MK Council Services have been reduced or suspended, in particular :-
 - Household waste sites are closed
 - The Civic offices are closed
 - Weekly Green waste collections will be suspended after this week. Any food waste that cannot be composted in the garden should go in the Black bags.
 - MK Libraries are closed
 - All play areas are closed
 - There are temporary changes to bus timetables (If you need specific timetable information we can print it off and deliver to you.)

If you are online up to date information can be found from the link in the table overleaf.

- **MK Hospital** is now no longer permitting visitors with a few exceptions, if online there is a link in the table overleaf.
- As it is not possible to remain 2m apart when passing someone else the Canals & Rivers
 Trust have recommended <u>not</u> using the canal towpaths (also protecting those that live on the canal)
- Garages remain open, but you may wish to use hand sanitiser before and after filling up. MOTs due on or after 30/03/20 will automatically be extended for 6 months.
- The **Patch Allotments** remain open, but there are very specific rules to follow to stay safe, which have been emailed to all tenants and are posted on the notice boards at the Patch.
