Did you know...

... that Woughton once gave its name to a pioneering bus service? In the mid-70s, with the estates in Woughton filling up rapidly, the Development Corporation needed to provide a means of transport, especially into Bletchley - the main centre, before CMK and Milton Keynes Central station opened.

The Woughton Dial-a-Bus could be called by phone to pick residents up from almost anywhere in the Parish. Sadly, though hugely popular, it proved expensive to run and lasted little more than a year. But read more about this part of our local history, this coming weekend....
