

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN MILTON KEYNES – MK MARATHON) (TEMPORARY CLOSURES AND RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2018

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes intends to make an order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event, namely the Milton Keynes Marathon which is being promoted by Mr Andy Hully, Race Director, Milton Keynes Marathon. It is anticipated that the following temporary restrictions will be in effect on Monday 7th May 2018 at various times between 6.00am and 7.00pm and when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs. The effect of the proposed order will be as follows:-

### THE FOLLOWING LENGTHS OF ROAD WILL BE CLOSED (during the times stated below):-

#### FROM 6:00 AM TO 7:00 PM

- **V7 Saxon Street** from its junction with Denbigh Roundabout to its junction with Ashlands Roundabout.

#### FROM 9:00 AM TO 12:00 PM

- **V7 Saxon Street** from its junction with South Saxon Roundabout to its junction with Eaglestone Roundabout;
- **H6 Childs Way** from its junction with South Witan Roundabout to its junction with South Secklow Roundabout;
- **South Saxon Roundabout;**
- **Avebury Boulevard, CMK** (both sides) from its junction with South Seventh Street to its junction with South Eighth Street;
- **Midsummer Boulevard, CMK** (both sides) from its junction with Upper Second Street to its junction with Saxon Gate;
- **Silbury Boulevard, CMK** (both sides) from its junction with Upper Second Street to its junction with Saxon Gate;
- **Saxon Gate, CMK** (both sides) from its junction with Silbury Boulevard to its junction with South Saxon Roundabout;
- **Witan Gate, CMK** (both sides) from its junction with Silbury Boulevard to its junction with Midsummer Boulevard;
- The entire lengths of **Upper Second Street, Upper Fourth Street, Upper Fifth Street and Upper Seventh Street.**

#### FROM 9:30 AM TO 12:00 PM

- **V7 Saxon Street** from its junction with Eaglestone Roundabout to its junction with Coffee Hall Roundabout;
- **H7 Chaffron Way** from its junction with Rainbow Drive, Leadenhall to its junction with Harrier Drive, Eaglestone;
- **Eaglestone Roundabout;**
- **Golden Drive, Eaglestone** from its junction with Condor Close to its junction with Peregrine Close.

#### FROM 9.30 AM TO 1:30 PM

- **V7 Saxon Street** from its junction with Coffee Hall Roundabout to its junction with Ashlands Roundabout;
- **H9 Groveway** from its junction with Redmoor Roundabout to its junction with Simpson Roundabout;
- **Ashland Roundabout.**

#### FROM 9:30 AM TO 5:00 PM

- **Dodkin, Beanhill** from its junction with V7 Saxon Street to a point in line with the boundary line of numbers 7 and 8 Dodkin;
- **Wastel, Beanhill** from its junction with V7 Saxon Street to its junction with Perrydown.

#### FROM 10:00 AM TO 10:30 AM

- **Coffee Hall Roundabout;**
- **H8 Standing Way** from its junction with Chapter, Coffee Hall to its junction with Hospital Roundabout.

#### FROM 10:00 AM TO 12:30 PM

- **Newport Road, Woolstone** from its junction with Marshalls Lane to its junction with Pattison Lane.

#### FROM 10:15 AM TO 12:00 PM

- **Newport Road, Woughton-on-the-Green** from its junction with The Green to its junction with Baskerfield Road.
- **The Green, Woughton-on-the-Green** its entire length.

**FROM 10:45 AM TO 1:00 PM**

- **Simpson Road, Simpson** from its junction with Simpson Drive to its junction with Beales Lane.

**FROM 10:45 AM TO 1:30 PM**

- **Old Groveway, Simpson** its entire length.

**FROM 11:00 AM TO 1:45 PM**

- **Beaufort Drive, Willen** between its junctions with Granville Square;
- **Granville Square car park, Willen;**
- **The Junction of Yeomens Drive and V10 Brickhill Street.**

**FROM 12:00 PM TO 4:30 PM**

- **Moorgate, Leadenhall** its entire length;
- **The junction of Palace Square and Moorgate, Leadenhall.**

**THE FOLLOWING DIVERSION ROUTES WILL BE SIGNED DURING THE EVENT WHILST V6 GRAFTON STREET, V8 MARLBOROUGH STREET AND H8 STANDING WAY ARE CLOSED:-**

**FROM WEST TO EAST (FROM 9:00 TO 5:00 PM)**

- Via V6 Grafton Street, Grafton Gate, CMK, H5 Portway and V8 Marlborough Street.

**FROM EAST TO WEST (FROM 9:00 TO 5:00 PM)**

- Via V8 Marlborough Street, H5 Portway, Grafton Gate and Grafton Street.

**TO ACCESS THE HOSPITAL (FROM 10:00 AM 10:30 AM)**

- Via V6 Grafton Street, Grafton Gate, CMK, H5 Portway and V8 Marlborough Street. *Please note that emergency vehicles will be permitted access through Coffee Hall Roundabout*

**THE FOLLOWING PORTE COCHERES WILL BE CLOSED (FROM 9:30 AM TO 12:00PM):**

- **Silbury Boulevard, CMK** (both sides) (Between North Second Street and North Ninth Street);
- **Midsummer Boulevard, CMK** (both sides) (Between Upper Second Street and Saxon Gate).

**THE FOLLOWING U-TURN MANEUVER BAN WILL BE DISABLED (FROM 9:30 AM TO 12:00 PM):-**

- **Avebury Boulevard, CMK** (northbound carriageway) at its junction with Avebury Boulevard.

**THE FOLLOWING ROADS WILL BE NO WAITING DURING (during the times stated below):-**

- **Newport Road, Woolstone** from its junction with Marshalls Lane to its junction with Pattison Lane.
- **St Stephens Drive, Bolbeck Park** from its junction with Bernay Gardens to its junction with Hobart Crescent.

As this is a rolling closure the temporary restrictions will only apply whilst the competitors pass along the above stated roads. All roads will reopen once the final runner has passed through and it is safe to do so.

There shall be no other exemptions from the provisions of the Order other than for emergency services vehicles, military vehicles on operational duties and those vehicles required in connection with the event.


The made Order will come into operation on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2017 at 6.00am and will continue in force for a maximum period of 3 days or until the completion of the event whichever shall be the sooner. It is anticipated that the restrictions will be required for one day only.

A copy of the proposed Order, statement of reasons for making the Order, and maps showing the areas referred to may be inspected during opening hours at **Milton Keynes Library**, 555 Silbury Boulevard, Milton Keynes, and during normal office hours at Milton Keynes Council, Civic Offices, 1 Saxon Gate East, Central Milton Keynes.

Any person committing a breach of the Order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
