What goes where?

CLEAR SACKS only these items for recycling please...

- ✓ Mixed paper, magazines and envelopes
- ✓ Cardboard (must be broken down to fit into the sack)
- Food and drink cartons
- Drinks cans
- ✓ Food tins
- Empty aerosol spray cans
- ✔ Plastic bottles and lids
- Plastic food trays and pots



These items must NOT be put into the clear recycling sacks.

- ✗ Food waste (place in your green bin)
- Dirty nappies (in your black rubbish bag)
- X Clothes, bedding and other textiles (in your black rubbish bag)
- ✗ Broken glass (in your black rubbish bag wrapped up)
